For aspirations week, as well as learning about different careers, HEP have also decided to focus on learning a new skill over the week too. As a group, we decided that each class could focus on learning parts of a new language. Every class has a child who speaks another language as well as English so we would like every class to choose a language that someone in your class speaks to focus on. For example: In 4SB, Anna can speak Russian so we are going to focus on learning bits of Russian.

Then, we came up with a list of things you could learn in that language:

- Learn numbers 1 – 10
- Greetings/manners
- How to answer the register
- Colours
- Food
- Days of the week/months

As a separate idea, Stanley suggested that we could also learn about that country too and create a piece of work around it to go on display.
